In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 35 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 (Central Act 37 of 1970), the Government of Kerala hereby publish for general information the following draft rules to amend the Kerala Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Rules, 1974.



Notice is hereby given that any objection or suggestion with respect to the draft received from any person within 42 days from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette will be considered by the Government. Objections or suggestions, if any, shall be addressed to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Labour and Skills (E) Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram.

DRAFT RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Amendment Rules, 2020.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*— In the Kerala Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Rules, 1974,—

(1) In rule 2, after clause (f) the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-

“(fa) Labour Commissionerate Automation system means a software owned and operated by the Labour department to cater end to end solutions to the employers, employees and labour administrators;”

(2) In rule 17.

(a) in sub-rule (1) for the words “in triplicate” the words “through Labour Commissionerate Automation System” shall be substituted;

(b) for sub -rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be inserted;

" (2) Every payment of fees for the application referred to in sub-rule (1), prescribed for the registration of establishment shall be remitted through Labour Commissionerate Automation System; "

(c) sub-rules (3) and (4) shall be omitted;

(3) In rule 21.

(a) in sub-rule (1), for the words “ in triplicate”, the words “through Labour Commissionerate Automation system” shall be substituted and sub-rules (3) and (4) shall be omitted;

(b) sub-rule (5) shall be renumbered as (3) and in the re numbered sub-rule (3) for the words "also be accompanied by a treasury receipt" the words " be remitted through Labour Commissionerate Automation System" shall be substituted;



(4) In rule 29, for sub-rule (2) the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“(2) “Every such application shall be made in form VII through Labour Commissionerate Automation system and shall be made not less than Thirty days before the date on which licence expires, and if the application is so made, the licence shall be renewed automatically”.
