S. R. O. No. 409/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Payment of Wages Act, 1936 (Central Act 4 of 1936), the Government of Kerala hereby exclude the establishments in plantation sector from the Schedule to the notification issued under G. O. (P) No. 35/2017/LBR dated 9th May, 2017 and published as S. R. O. No. 243/2017 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 951 dated 9th May, 2017 and consequently make the following amendment to the said notification, namely:—

AMENDMENT

In the Schedule to the said notification, serial number 27 in column (1) and the entry against it in column (2) shall be omitted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

In exercise of its powers conferred under section 6 of the Payment of Wages Act, 1936 (Central Act 4 of 1936), the Government, as per notification issued under G. O. (P) No. 35/2017/LBR dated 9th May, 2017 and published as S. R. O. No. 243/2017 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary. No. 951 dated 9th May, 2017, have specified 39 industrial and other establishments, the employer of which shall pay to every person employed in such industrial or other establishments, the wages only by cheque or by crediting the wages in his bank account.

Now, considering the difficulties being experienced by the plantation sector employees due to the non-availability of sufficient banking facilities, ATM etc., in the plantation areas most of which are situated in remote hill areas far away from townships, Government have decided to omit the plantation sector from the Schedule to the said notification in public interest. Hence, the said notification has to be suitably amended.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
